Join us for a learning journey and learning camp into a lived experience of the world of [Kufunda Learning Village](#) in Zimbabwe.

It is clear that the world is living through a big transition. In it much is falling apart, the old is crumbling in many ways and many places, but the new is not fully born yet, not fully known.

The new story is born in the space of uncertainty of frail new beginnings. Zimbabwe has been in this space for over a decade now. We are learning a lot. And it's about more than resilience, it is about crafting a new story, a new way. It is about finding our way home. This learning journey, this Kufunda camp, is about connecting to the new story as we are already beginning to live it – and it is about knitting our selves and our souls back together moving way beyond the break down.

Kufunda Village is an incubator of new ways of living; but also a place of spirit – held by the ancestors at our backs. It is a place where new possibilities can arise, where magic is made tangible!

Post Learning Journey Wilderness Adventure

When you travel so far you might wish to join us in one of the most remarkable parks in Zimbabwe (and possibly Africa!). Mana Pools is a park for the animals. There are no fences anywhere, and people are free to wander through the park at leisure. This makes for incredible encounters. Elephants wandering into your camp while you're having dinner, or lion encounters on foot. Mana Pools is on the Zambezi river, and as we will be at the beginning of the dry season the animals will be migrating to the river for water, making sightings inevitable.
